



Agreement

between

The International Union of Architects and The International Federation of Landscape Architects

The President of the International Union of Architects (UIA) and the President of the International Federation of Landscape Architects (IFLA) see mutual benefits between the two organizations, with the aim of creating an alliance of professional institutions in architecture, environment and design to better serve the professional needs of their members, associated partners and thereby society.

UIA and IFLA agree to the following points:

1. The UIA and IFLA recognize the distinct nature and standing of the separate professional institutes for architecture and landscape architecture. (GS-15 aug 06)
2. The UIA and IFLA agree to this collaboration in order to strengthen the role of architecture and landscape architecture, to reinforce the importance of the context of buildings in their settings to enhance the quality of life of human beings, and to provide an enhanced service to support their members' professional needs through joint development, commitment and action.
3. The UIA will be responsible for the functions and the profession of the architect and IFLA will be responsible for the functions and the profession of landscape architect.
4. The UIA and IFLA liaison committee will prepare plans and make recommendations to their Committees and Councils in furtherance of this collaboration.
5. The Executive committees of the UIA and IFLA shall meet regularly to discuss matters of common interest.
6. Both signatories to this Agreement will inform the counterpart organisation of the events and activities being undertaken by their organisation.
7. Both will establish a link to the other on the web-sites of their respective organisations.
8. Where appropriate, each will invite the counterpart organisation to be officially represented at the Main Events of their organisation.

This Agreement shall remain in effect until either organisation communicates in writing to the counterpart organisation their desire for its termination, but in any event it will be reconsidered by both parties every three years.
