

**Skanska: Bridging Prague Award****PRELIMINARY JURY MEETING MINUTES - May 18, 2012**

**10:10** Initial introduction by Director of Competition and Reviewer of Competition.

All jury members present were announced and introduced to each other.

Jury members signed in and signed testimonials.

Judging guidelines were reviewed.

Recommendations and comments of Competition Organizers were discussed, particularly:

- The official extension of the competition deadline by one day, due to technical difficulties with the Competition computer server
- Recommendation to jury to accept entries received both before the initial deadline and before the one day extension
- Description of seven entries that for various reasons did not meet the stated requirements of the Competition
- Description of proposed structure of First Round voting by Director of Competition, to be as follows:
  - Total number of submittals will be divided into 5 equal Groups (20 per Group and 21 for Chairman AG)
  - Each jury member will individually review their Group and will note important characteristics.
  - For the full Jury review, each Jury member will quickly present and describe their Group of 20-21 projects to the other Jury members, but WITHOUT making recommendations.
  - During the presentation of all the projects, the full Jury will vote on each qualified submittal to decide if it will pass the First Round.
  - Jury members agreed with this format.
